Prof ZHANG serves as an advisor for the development of a WHO Learning Strategy, the Board Member of the China Administration Society, China Society of Emergency Management, and China Volunteer Service Federation. His research focuses on public management and governance, including risk governance, resilience and sustainable development, volunteering, and social innovation. He received his Ph.D. in Management from SPPM at Tsinghua University (2004) and was a Harvard-Yenching Visiting Scholar at Harvard (2011-2012).

Topic: Nothing about us without us—A case study on supporting and empowering disabled people in dealing with the COVID-19 pandemic in China

It has been confirmed by many studies that, being most vulnerable, disabled people in the COVID-19 Pandemic are often left behind in emergencies. According to the statistics of the Sixth National Census, there were about 85.02 million disabled people in China, accounting for 6.34% of the total population. The COVID-19 pandemic has highlighted additional difficulties that disabled people may face, such as barriers to access to information, lifestyle discomforts, and disrupted access to healthcare. The disability support network is a spontaneous and temporary volunteer network dedicated to providing disabled persons with support to deal with the challenges mentioned above and fight against the outbreak. This concept is the practice of evidence-based policymaking. Data obtained in this case revealed that the role of disabled people has the great potential to shift from the recipient to the participant.

題目：「沒有我們的參與，就不要做關於我們的決定」— 關於殘疾人支持和賦權應對 COVID-19大流行病的案例研究

危機情況下殘疾人往往被忽視，許多研究都證實了殘疾人在疫情中的特殊脆弱性。根據第六次全國人口普查數據顯示，在2010年末，中國約有8502萬殘疾人，佔總人口6.34%。疫情下殘疾人可能面臨更多的困難，如獲取資訊的障礙、疫情生活模式的難以適應，和常規醫療服務的中斷等。殘疾人支援網路是一個疫情期間自發的臨時志願者網路，致力於為殘疾人提供支援，也是一次循證決策的有效實踐。在這個案例分享中，殘疾人的角色從被動接受者轉變為主動參與者，為危機下社會個體的共融提供了值得借鑒的創新路徑。
